Church Building Evangelism

I remember seeing a sign posted so all those leaving the building could see it. It said something like, “Evangelism begins as you leave this building and extends to all the world.” There is no question that His words, “Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations” and “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature” (Matt. 28:19; Mark 16:15) cause our eyes to look places far removed from where we are. May I suggest that evangelism starts as we leave worship, but actually can begin long before we depart?

Not everyone can conduct a complete Bible study with others, but there are five vital things that every member can do which can open the doors for the teaching of the lost. How many of these are part of your life?

We all can welcome visitors. There is no way to overemphasize the importance of the first impressions made on those who visit our services. From the moment you exit your car, start looking for those you do not know. That friendly word spoken to them as they walk toward our building will never be forgotten. Do not be concerned that the person you greet might be a member you have not met; go ahead and greet them. If they are members, your life will be enriched!

There are five vital things that every member can do in evangelism

We all can “pass visitors on” to others. Here’s the idea behind “passing visitors on” to others. Tell them about the classes we have or bring them to our greeters. Then, if you find out where they work, where they were born or where they now live, use this information and introduce them to someone with similar interests! The point is, do not just walk away from them. Get other members involved in their lives.

We all can write to visitors. The addresses of our visitors are available on Sunday nights, and the opportunity is given to write to visitors every week. Write them a brief note, remind them who you are and encourage them to come again. Of course, you can write all visitors, but those you meet will remember you.

We all can tell others about visitors. We must do all we can to reach those who reach out to us. Tell the elders, preachers or secretaries who you met and what you learned about them. This helps so much in following up on those who come our way.

We all can look for visitors to come again. When you meet visitors in the parking lot, those who happen to sit next to you, or those who were passed on to you, be on the lookout for them at other services. First impressions are so important, but the “second greeting” from you can have an even greater impact. So, let us all begin evangelism long before we leave the building!

11 “Be’s” for Training Children in and for Worship

Training children to sit and to behave in worship can be a challenge, but it is a challenge worth taking and mastering—for the child’s good, for your good and for the church’s good. Children have been part of God’s assemblies since Old Testament times (cf. Deut. 29:10-13; 31:9-13). To properly train them and nurture them in the ways of the Lord, children need to be raised in worship assemblies and properly instructed in the behavior and demeanor of worship.

Be ready. Prepare your child, starting the night before, to focus on worshiping God. Talk about it. Pray about it. Before worship starts, go to the restroom and get that out of the way.

Be insistent. You are the parent, and your child is the child (not vice versa). Set high expectations for your child’s behavior; they will achieve them with your help and encouragement.

Be consistent. Once you have set and communicated your expectations to your child about behavior in worship, enforce them and do so regularly and uniformly. Inconsistent discipline confuses a child rather than comforts.

Be involved. Involve yourself in all aspects of the worship and assist your child in participating, as well, to the extent to which they are able. Set a good example.

Find ways for your child to be appropriately active in the worship.

Be practical. Find ways for your child, appropriate to his/her age, to be appropriately active in the worship. Children can sing, pray, give and should be taught to do so. Sermon time should not be play time; use Bible books and activity sheets for the young and simple sermon notes for the older.

Be “up-front.” The further to the back you sit, the more distractions there will be to challenge for your children’s attention (and yours). Sitting near the front helps keep focused on the service (and always face the front, too).

Be sensitive. While your child’s misbehavior, talkativeness or constant stirring may not bother you, be mindful of others sitting around you, near you or behind you, who are trying to worship.

Be humble. Seek advice from “older” Christians whose children behave appropriately in worship. Humbly consider any counsel offered to you.

Be prayerful. Don’t try to bring your child up without the Lord’s help. Pray for wisdom, understanding and courage.

Be patient. No child is or ever will be perfect. Even your greatest efforts will be met with resistance and even failure. Don’t give up. Don’t give in. Stay the course.

Be big-picture-focused! In the midst of all the little details, keep your eyes on the ultimate goal—raising one of God’s children to grow to love Him and to go home to Him!

Does the devil even know who you are?

There is an almost-humorous event that happened in the city of Ephesus, while Paul was ministering there (Acts 19:11-15). He had been so successful in proclaiming the name of the Lord Jesus, performing miracles in the name of the Lord and casting out demons in the name of the Lord that some imposters tried to duplicate his power over evil spirits by simply speaking the name "Jesus." Their powerless attempt failed miserably, which led the demon to mock them.

Can you imagine this? The evil spirit spoke out, "**Jesus I know**" (i.e., a knowledge that is based on experience, recognizing Jesus' authority). "**Paul I know**" (i.e., a knowledge that is acquainted with someone). "**But who are you?**" The demon had been troubled by Jesus and His deeds; the demon had been troubled by Paul and his deeds. But, these imposters had never done anything to show up on the demon's radar of trouble, so he didn't know them.

Makes me wonder: does the devil know who we are? Have we ever done anything to trouble him? – DS

God's judgment doesn't have to be frightening!

The last verse of Psalm 96 begins with the word "for." That is not unusual, for other psalms follow that same pattern and the word is found about 9,000 times in the entire Bible. The word "for" often introduces a cause, the effects of which have already been enumerated. (Example: "For" in Galatians 3:27 is the cause [baptized] of the effect in verse 26 [being sons of God].)

Look at Psalm 96. The last verse reveals, "For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth." The judgment of God is certain, and in this verse, it is set forth as a cause for action. What actions are called for in Psalm 96, as a result of (or effect of) impending judgment?

"Sing to the Lord...Sing to the Lord...Bless His name...Proclaim the good news of His salvation ...Declare His glory among the nations...Give to the Lord...Give to the Lord the glory due His name...Bring an offering...Come into His courts...Worship the Lord...Tremble before Him... Rejoice...Be glad...Be joyful." When you think of the judgment, is this your reaction? – DS

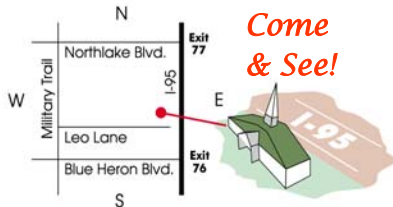
