This life is the only "preparation opportunity" that we

have for heaven! God has graciously shown us the way (and what a glorious way it is!), but once this life has passed, there are no "do-overs" or "second chances." And, I cannot afford to miss heaven! Think for a moment what that means to each of us.

If Scripture has anything to do with going to heaven, I cannot afford to be wrong about the authority of Scripture! It is only through God's Word

that we know anything about heaven and anything about how to get to heaven. Of course, "There is a way that seems right to a man" (Prov. 14:12), but it "is the way of death," not of eternal life. Only Jesus has "the words of eternal life" (John 6:68), therefore, it is has been placed upon us, through the demands of Scripture, to "do all in the name of the Lord Jesus" (Col. 3:17). His Word must be our sole authority in religious matters, for only through obedience thereto can we enter and enjoy the blessings of heaven (Matt. 7:21).

If baptism has anything to do with going to heaven, I cannot afford to be wrong about the purpose of baptism! Man's deadliest affliction today is sin, for sin separates man from God now (Isa. 59:1-2) and sin will keep man from going to heaven (1 Cor. 6:9; Gal. 5:21). Man's greatest need today is the complete removal of every sin he commits, which is only possible through the blood of Jesus (Rev. 1:5). God (not any man) tied the washing away of one's sins directly to one's sub-

mission to immersion (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 22:16; Where we get to Rom. 6:3-4). Therefore, baptism of penitent believers is essential to enter and enjoy the blessings of be with the Lord heaven (John 3:3-7). **Himself forever**

If the church has anything to do with going and ever! Where to heaven, I cannot afford to be wrong about the identification of the church! The church of the New Testament is not of human origin but of Divine origin

(Isa. 2:2-4; Matt. 16:18). It is not comprised of varying denominational organizations (Gal. 1:6-12; John 17:20-21) but is singular (as taught in Scripture) in its doctrine and practice (Eph. 4:4; 1 Cor. 1:10; 1 Pet. 4:11). Human organizations are not essential for eternal life, but only those who are part of Christ's kingdom will enter and enjoy heaven (1 Cor. 15:24; Heb. 12:23).

To depart from this life and to "be with Christ...is very much better" (Phil. 1:23). I cannot afford to miss heaven; therefore, I cannot afford to be wrong about heavenly things!

Wrestling is not fake!

The Christian life is depicted as a walk (Eph. 5:2-16), a run (Heb. 12:1-2), a war (2 Tim. 2:3-4), along with a number of other metaphors to help us get a "mental picture." There is an interesting one found in Ephesians 6:12—Christians are wrestlers.

The English word "wrestle" (and its Greek original) is found only this one time in the New Testament. The wrestling in which Christians are to engage is not against fellow humans but against the devil and his evil forces. The Greek word used for wrestle means, "to throw, to swing; a contest (particularly a close hand-to-hand fight) between two until one hurls the other down and holds him down with his hand upon the neck."

While much of the wrestling on TV is fake or rehearsed, your wrestling "against" the devil is very real! He is trying to pin you and to keep you from pinning him! However, when you have the Lord's strength, the power of His might and God's whole armor (6:10-11), you're in a tag-team match against Satan with Jesus as your partner! You only lose if you leave the contest! -DS

Self-examinations

Our physical health is of such tremendous importance to us that we constantly monitor certain health issues that come our way. We are wary of certain spots on our skin, growths that appear, pains in certain places, problems with our vision, etc., etc., etc. While we realize it or not, we are doing regular self-examinations to keep ourselves as healthy as possible.

How important is your spiritual health to you? As important as your physical health? How often do you do selfexams on your soul? The Great Physician prescribes, "Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves" (2 Cor. 13:5). Are you living in a right relationship with Christ? Are you "in the faith"? Is "Jesus Christ in you" (end of verse 5)? Have the "old things" truly "passed away" (5:17)? Are you living as "a new creation" of Christ?

Self-examinations need to look at our conduct (1 Pet. 4:1-3), speech (Jas. 3:1-12), thoughts (Phil. 4:8), motives (Rom. 14:22-23), faith (Heb. 11:6), beliefs (Rev. 22:18-19), teachings (Gal. 1:11-12), love (1 John 4:7-5:3), eternal destiny (2 Thess. 1:7-9; Rom. 2:5-11), etc. -DS




