

Simple Truths About the Sabbath

It is remarkable how clearly the Lord can state a matter and how difficult it is for man to understand His words. When one approaches the Bible with a predetermined mindset, very simple statements of truth can become difficult for men to understand. However, when one studies the Bible openly,

these simple statements open the doors to finding God's will. As an illustration of this, consider the following truths about the Sabbath. The format used in this study will be a question and answer format with each question being based on the truth learned in the preceding paragraph. Keep in mind that the Sabbath is part of answers are from the Ten Commandments.

What was the covenant made with the God's answers! Jews at Mt. Sinai (also called Mt. Horeb)? "And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, even ten commandments; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone" (Deut. 4:13).

Had God ever made this covenant with the ancestors (like Noah, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob) of those who came to Mt. Sinai (also called Mt. Horeb)? "The LORD our God made a covenant with us in Horeb. The LORD made not this covenant with our fathers, but with us, even us, who are all of us here alive this day. The LORD talked with you face to face in the mount out of the midst of the fire" (Deut. 5:2-4).

Did this covenant, not made with the fathers, include the Ten Commandments? "Keep the Sabbath day to sanctify it, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee. Six days thou shalt labor, and do all thy work" (Deut. 5:12-13).

Why was the Sabbath (a rest day) given to Jews who were with Moses at Mt. Sinai (also called Mt. Horeb)? "And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of Egypt, and that the Lord thy God brought thee out Notice that evethence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out ry word given as arm: **therefore** the LORD thy God commanded **thee** to

keep the Sabbath day" (Deut. 5:15).

Does the New Testament (the new covenant) include the Ten Commandments given at Mt. Sinai (also called Mt. Horeb)? "Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new cove-

nant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was a husband unto them, saith the LORD" (Deut. 31:31-32).

Now, before accepting the complex ideas given by those who bind the Sabbath on Christians, take time to read these simple truths. Notice that every word given as answers are from God! Listen to God's simple truths!

We are living in a society that believes and has been irreparably affected by a philosophy that asserts, "If you say it long enough and loud enough, it will be accepted as truth." It doesn't matter what "it" is, either. "It" can be some far-out or contemptible idea, but (remember the philosophy) just

say it "long enough and loud enough" and people will accept it.

Darwinian evolution is being taught to our children. Less than 200 years ago, a man began to claim that the complex human body was nothing enough and loud more than the product of a multi-million year evolution from a single-celled amoeba. Oh, and to support his claim, he did not have a single shred of evidence. But, he said it long enough and loud enough, and he got others to say it with him, so now that damnable heresy is being taught as truth to our children. Who would have ever thought that to be possible?

Homosexual relations are being presented as normal and even "the latest, coolest trend." In 1987, two gay men published an article entitled, "The Overhauling of Straight America," in which they stated, "The first order of business is desensitization of the American public concerning gays and gay rights." Think about that word, "desensitization." If you talk about "gay rights" long enough and loud enough, and then if you promote "gay marriage" long enough and loud enough, people will become "desensitized" to it and will just begin to accept it. Now, we live in a society where this "vile," "unnatural," "shameful" "error" (all words from Romans 1:26-28) is praised, glorified, venerated and recommended wholeheartedly to our children. Who would have ever thought that to be possible?

> Just go down the list of things that are bringing down our society today-murdering unwanted babies, drinking parties, college campus orgies, denigration of marriage, fatherless homes, marijuana, etc., etc. At some point in our past history, sinful behaviors and lifestyles were seen as sinful. But, over time, just parade these things in front of people over and over, do it long enough and loud enough, and people will be convinced to accept whatever is being sold!

Brethren, we cannot remain silent! When error and unrighteousness is the only voice that is being heard, it won't take long until error and unrighteousness are "the norm" and "the truth" that everyone accepts. You may think that God's truth doesn't have much of a chance today, but what would happen if we all spoke the truth and stood for the truth "long enough and loud enough" for people to hear it over and over? Do you think that truth could win? Let us say: "I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for IT is the power of God!



Wiped Out

"Repent therefore, and turn to God so that your sins may be wiped out" (Acts 3:19). In an old, one-room, country schoolhouse years ago, a boy was doing very poor work. About halfway through the school year, though, something the teacher said By Josh Blackmer inspired him. He diligently applied himself to

his work. His grades improved. His assignments were neat and attractive. He finished the year with very good marks, and his parents were quite proud. On visitation day at the end of the year, however, the boy's heart sank as he saw his mother looking at his workbooks from that school year. He knew that the first half of those workbooks were full of messy work and unsightly blots. He watched as his mother leafed through them and was surprised that his mother was quite pleased as she called his father over to exam-

ine them. He discovered that his kind teacher had removed all of his work from the first half of the year and only left the work that was neat.

The point in life where we have a change of heart is called "repentance." Sometimes in the Bible this change is simply called "turning" (Acts 3:19). When we make an aboutface, God covers up all of our shabby deeds from the past. He forgives, which means he removes them from the record book. In ancient times, writing was removed from leather scrolls by washing or sponging the ink off, and this metaphor was employed frequently in the Bible. The Psalmist prayed, "Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions....Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities" (Ps. 51:1, 9). We can relate with the psalmist in feeling the remorse and guilt of sin. Many have cried out with a burden of guilt. "Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I

> dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips..." (Isa. 6:5). "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, 'Men and brethren, what shall we do?" (Acts 2:36-37). "For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do...O wretched man that I am! who shall

deliver me from the body of this death?" (Rom. 7:19, 24). We all have been there at some point in our lives, and perhaps we will again. It is important to remember that we can have confidence before the throne of grace (Heb. 4:16), if we will repent or turn away from doing sin. God declares, "I, I am He who blots out your transgressions for my own sake, and I will not remember your sins...I have swept away your transgressions like a cloud, and your sins like mist" (Isa. 43:25; 44:22).

"Do you want to permanently delete?"

Computers and electronic devices have a built-in failsafe to ensure that you don't accidentally delete a file that you intended to keep. When you click on delete, it will not immediately delete the file. Instead, it will ask you, "Are you sure you want to delete this file?" for the Day Is there a spiritual application here? Every time a Christian commits a sin, he desperately needs that sin "deleted" from his account. First, he might regret that he did it and want it gone, but that doesn't delete it. Next, he may resolve that he will never do it again, but that doesn't delete it. Then, he may reform his habits regarding that sin, but still the sin hasn't been deleted. Finally, he prays, "Father, I have sinned. Please forgive me" (2 Sam. 12:13; Acts 8:22). Once God knows that you are absolutely certain that you want that sin deleted from your account, He will remove it and never recall it again (Heb. 8:12). It will be permanently deleted! - DS

You are in control, not someone or something else!

Have you ever lost your temper with someone? Who's fault was it—yours or the other person? Have you ever become angry with your computer, television, remote control or some electronic device? Who's fault was it—yours or the electronic equipment? Have you ever hit your thumb with a hammer and

> yelled a curse word? Who's fault was it—yours or the hammer's?

There are all sorts of people and things in this life that seem to be able to "trigger" a response in us. But, when we lose our temper or become enraged or shout a curse word or want to hurt

someone, we are the ones personally responsible for that kind of response (not the other person or thing). As much as I might like to blame "that mean person" or "that dumb computer," they hold no control over my words and my actions. That's all on me.

That's why a part of the fruit of the Spirit is "self-control" (Gal. 5:21-23). That's why in Christian growth, we are to add to our knowledge "self-control" (2 Pet. 1:6). How's your self-control?


