## The Unseen Universe

Have you ever thought about why God made galaxies which even today remain unknown and invisible to mankind? For thousands of years, the distant stars and galaxies existed, but until the development in recent years of more powerful telescopes, no one knew they were even there. Why did He make them? There are likely many reasons, yet each of them declares His glorious existence. Recently, while reading the Psalms, I discovered an additional reason which I had overlooked as to why He made them.

### Why He Made the Earth

The Bible clearly states the reason He created the earth. We think about that first home, the Garden of Eden, as being made so Adam and Eve would have a place to live. However, the picture is far greater than this. Isaiah described the creation of the earth, and then says that “God formed it to be inhabited” (Isa. 45:18). Jeremiah, speaking for God, said, “I have made the earth . . . by My great power and by My outstretched arm, and have given it to whom it seemed proper to Me” (Jer. 27:5).

It is obvious why He created the earth, but why did He create galaxies which are invisible to man? It is estimated that are 100,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000 (100 octillion) stars. Why so many, when they cannot be seen?

**Why did God make a million, million galaxies which no man would ever see?**

### Why He Made the Universe

The immediate answer is so that mankind, as they learned more about our universe, would understand how the heavens declare His glory (Psa. 19:1). But, there are more answers. Consider the one found in Psalm 115.

Read the second phrase in verse sixteen. The psalmist said, “But the earth He has given to the children of men” (Psa. 115:16). Now look at an implication found in the first phrase. “The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord’s.” Do you see the contrast? Our God has given the earth to us as *our* abode, but the heaven of heavens, the universe, is *His*! He made that invisible universe, which we are just beginning to be able to see, for Himself. Those unseen galaxies (no one knows how many more are yet to be found), show His glory, but God revealed they were made for Him.

A childish view of this—for how could even the wisest man fathom such profound truths—could imagine the joy a child has of going to Disney and every day visiting a new park. Each one surpasses all that he has seen. That child might then think of God going from galaxy to galaxy to see those remarkable sites throughout His created universe. Each venue surpassing all that had been seen in grandeur. Mankind may someday go to some nearby galaxy, but God sees them all every day. *O the marvels of His unfathomable wisdom in His creation!*

## Worshiping Jesus in His “Absence”?

In Matthew 2, wise men came to Jerusalem seeking “the King” and ultimately found him in a home in the city of Bethlehem. They found Jesus as a child, less than two years old, and the Bible says that they “fell down and worshiped Him” (Matt. 2:11).

This was the first time that men worshiped Jesus in His very presence. What a sight!

As you read through the life of Jesus, there were at least nine other occasions when individuals worshiped Jesus in His very presence. “A leper came and worshiped Him” (Matt. 8:2). A man of the Gadarenes, demon-possessed by Legion, “when he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and worshiped Him” (Mark 5:6). Jairus, one of the rulers of the synagogue near Capernaum, “came and worshiped Him” (Matt. 9:18). After walking on the water to rescue and comfort His apostles, Jesus got into the boat and the apostles “came and worshiped Him” (Matt. 14:33). A Canaanite woman, whose daughter was severely demon-possessed, having found Jesus in the region of Tyre and Sidon, “came and worshiped Him” (Matt. 15:25). Jesus restored the sight of a man who was blind from birth, and with a heart of faith and gratitude, the man came and “worshiped Him” (John 9:38). The wife of Zebedee and mother of James and John came to Jesus, “worshiping Him” (Matt. 20:20). On His resurrection morning, when Jesus met and

greeted the women who came to the tomb, “they came and held Him by the feet and worshiped Him” (Matt. 28:9). Then, when the eleven disciples went to Galilee as Jesus had instructed, “they saw Him” and “worshiped Him” (Matt. 28:17).

From the time He was a child until the time of His resurrection, men and women were able to worship Jesus in His very presence. What an experience that must have been! Then, on the eastern slopes of the Mount of Olives, over against Bethany, Jesus “parted from them and was carried up into heaven” (Luke 24:50-51). What would the disciples do now? Jesus was gone; He was no longer in their presence. The very next verse states, “They worshiped Him” (Luke 24:52).

**They could not but fall down and worship Him, as if He was still present.**

The disciples did the same thing in Jesus’ absence as they had done in His presence—they worshiped Him! They were still full of awe! They were still full on wonder and amazement! They were still full of thanksgiving! They were still full of humility! They were still driven to honor and praise their King and their Savior! They could not but fall down and worship Him, as if He was still present, for in reality, true worshipers are still in His presence!

We may think that Jesus is not present today, but such a thought could not be further from the truth! He is here! Are you full of awe, wonder, thanksgiving and humility toward your Savior? Let us worship Him...in His presence!

## “Behold the Lamb of God”

Have you ever read a familiar Bible story and noticed something you never saw before? This happened to me the other night in our Family Group study.

We are going through the book, *You Want to Be Happy*, by Eric Owens. He is showing what true happiness looks like, and

why we as Christians should be motivated to be happy despite the circumstances. This particular study was on the concept of redemption. Mr. Owens brought up the story of Abraham preparing to sacrifice Isaac in Genesis 22. You remember that God asked Abraham to sacrifice his only son. So, they went to the mountain to make the offering. Along the way, Isaac asked, “Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, ‘My father!’ And he said, ‘Here I am, my son.’ And he said, ‘Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?’” (Gen. 22:7)? Abraham’s response was always, “God will provide.” We know that as Abraham was about to offer Isaac, an angel of the Lord told him to stop. Abraham looked up, and there was a ram in the bushes caught by its horns. God did provide. Hebrews chapter 11 tells us about that moment, “By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was offering up his only begotten son; it was he to whom it was said, ‘In Isaac

your descendants shall be called.’ He considered that God is able to raise people even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type” (Heb. 11:17-19).

This is where something came up that I had never thought of before. Hebrews said that Abraham received Isaac back as a type, a representation of future spiritual events. My focus was always on the Jesus and Isaac similarities. Both were

only begotten, both were to be sacrificed and both were children of promise. Only one was sacrificed and only one could have taken away the sins of the world. Jesus was represented by another figure in the story, the ram. Isaiah 53:7 mentions Christ as a sheep, “He was oppressed and He was

afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth.” John the baptizer also, “The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, ‘Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!’” (John 1:29)! The New Testament is full of this concept. The book of Revelation mentions it 31 times. How could I have missed this?

God was on that mountain with Abraham. God provided the needed sacrifice just as Abraham’s faith believed He would. God is with you in your mountains and valleys. He has provided the needed sacrifice that makes us able to approach the “throne of God and of the Lamb” (Rev 22:3).

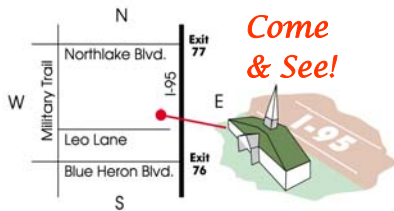
