## Words for the “Ugly, Dumb, Clumsy, Poor” People

Our world is so upside down. From the time a child enters school, he is confronted with the reality that if you are not cute, handsome or beautiful, you may not succeed. If you are not more intelligent than others, you might fail. If you are not wealthy, your chances of advancement may be quite limited. If you are not athletic, you may not be popular and well known among other students.

Beauty, brains, money and athleticism seem to be such an exaggerated measure of the worth of a person. It becomes obvious early in life, but take a look at the world in our adult lives. Little has changed. However, the measuring rod showing a person’s real worth is not found in these four things. The reason these have become the measure of a person is because while man looks on the outward appearance, the Lord looks on the heart (1 Sam. 16:7).

The words of Paul show those who mean the most to God. “For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called” (1 Cor. 1:26). These are not the called simply because their fleshly values, which actually are worthless, are so important to them.

When Jesus came He sought to bring every man to

Himself. All men were invited, but not all responded to His invitation. Who did respond? Read these words carefully. “The common people heard Him gladly” (Mark 12:37). Who are those common people? Not the beautiful, the intellectuals, the wealthy or the athletes. All men are called, but the majority do not respond and so very few of those “mighty” in this world.

James, the Lord’s brother, reminds us of this in his epistle. “Listen, my beloved brethren: Has not God chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him” (Jas. 2:5)? The world is so upside down. We honor the “mighty” in our society when in reality God does just the opposite.

So how do you feel about yourself? Those ideas you learned early in life and which are so much part of adult life are just wrong. The Messianic prophet proclaimed that when the Messiah came He would replace ashes with beauty (Isa. 61:3). Those the world sees as ugly become the beautiful bride of Christ. Those whom the world sees as ignorant have more understanding than their worldly teachers (Psa. 119:99). Those viewed as poor have a treasure that far surpasses all the worldly wealth (Matt. 16:26). Those who never excelled in any athletic event triumphantly receive a crown when they finish their race (2 Tim. 4:7-8).

## God’s Keys to True Happiness

Happiness. Everybody wants it. But it is so elusive. Well-meaning folks search for it in all sorts of places. Some seek it in material things. Some through substance abuse. Some through sexual escapades. Most through their own selfish ambitions.

On the other hand, there are some people who believe there is no way to be truly happy. Ask yourself, “Does God want me to be happy? Really? Truly happy?” Some are living under the delusion that God isn’t interested in them enjoying life or being happy. Such could not be further from the truth.

There is a secret to happiness that only Christians know. Do you want to know the insider’s scoop that God’s people have discovered? True happiness is not conditioned upon the erratic circumstances of life. Rather, true happiness is determined by one’s relationship with God and how that relationship works through the circumstances and people of life. Consider 1 Peter 3:8-12.

Peter addresses the situation when a Christian is served up “evil” and “reviling” from his worldly acquaintances (3:9). What is a Christian to do, and how does this have anything to do with happiness? In these situations, a Christian is to return “a blessing instead,” in order that he “might inherit a blessing.” God will give us something (i.e., “a blessing”) that

we don’t deserve (making us “happy”), and therefore, we should treat others in a way (i.e., with “a blessing”) that they don’t deserve! As Christians, we desire “to love life and see good days” (3:10). We want to find the true happiness that God has in store for us on earth! Here’s where it is.

**True happiness comes when we refrain our tongue from evil!** The easy thing to do when evil is spouted at us is to return in like manner! That will not result in true happiness!

**True happiness comes when we refrain our lips from speaking deceit!** It may bring a twisted satisfaction to lead people down a path paved with dishonesty, but that will not result in true happiness!

**True happiness comes when we turn away from evil!** We must test all things (1 Thess. 5:21), and then flee as far away from sin as we can! True happiness does not fraternize with sin!

**True happiness comes when we do good!** This is not addressing doing good in general, but doing good unto others (cf. Gal. 6:10). That’s where we will find true happiness!

**True happiness comes when we pursue true peace!** Being in an ongoing relationship with the Prince of Peace and helping others to find His peace brings true happiness!

Are you happy? Truly happy? Do you want to have a blessing from God? Then, be a blessing to others!

## Victory and Peace Perfect Peace

Columbia rejoices as peace comes to the country this month. Unbeknownst to the majority of us, the government of Columbia and the Marxist-Leninist group known as FARC (Revolutionary Armed Forces of Columbia) have been in conflict for 52 years. During that time, an estimated 260,000 people have died as a result of bombings, land mines and attacks. This past week, after two years of secret communication and 4 years of open negotiations, the two parties reached a “full, final and definitive accord.” A BBC reporter quoted FARC negotiator Rodrigo Granda, “There is no room for winners or losers when you achieve peace through negotiations... Colombia wins, death loses.”

Death lost an even greater battle thousands of years ago in a place called Golgotha. This strategic win by our Lord made all other wars pale in comparison to the amount of lives that were and are touched by this war. Paul wrote it this way, “O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY? O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING? The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law; but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Cor. 15:55-57). We were doomed to a death that we had no power over, an end that was beyond our control to do anything about. Death was our victor. This point is addressed again in the contrast between Adam and Christ, “For if by the transgression of the

one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ. So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men” (Rom. 5:17-18).

All have the opportunity of victory over sin and a right relationship with God through the sacrifice of Christ and being buried in the likeness of His sacrifice. “If we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, is never to die again; death no longer is master over Him. For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts, and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God” (Rom. 6:8-13).

In the peace that was attained by the love of God and the death of His Son, we have something that we would have never been able to attain on our own—victory over the death we deserved. We, the obedient, win and death loses.

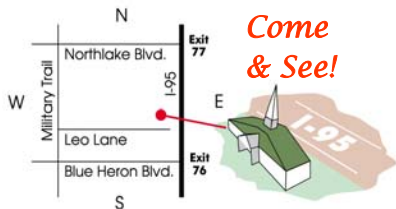
