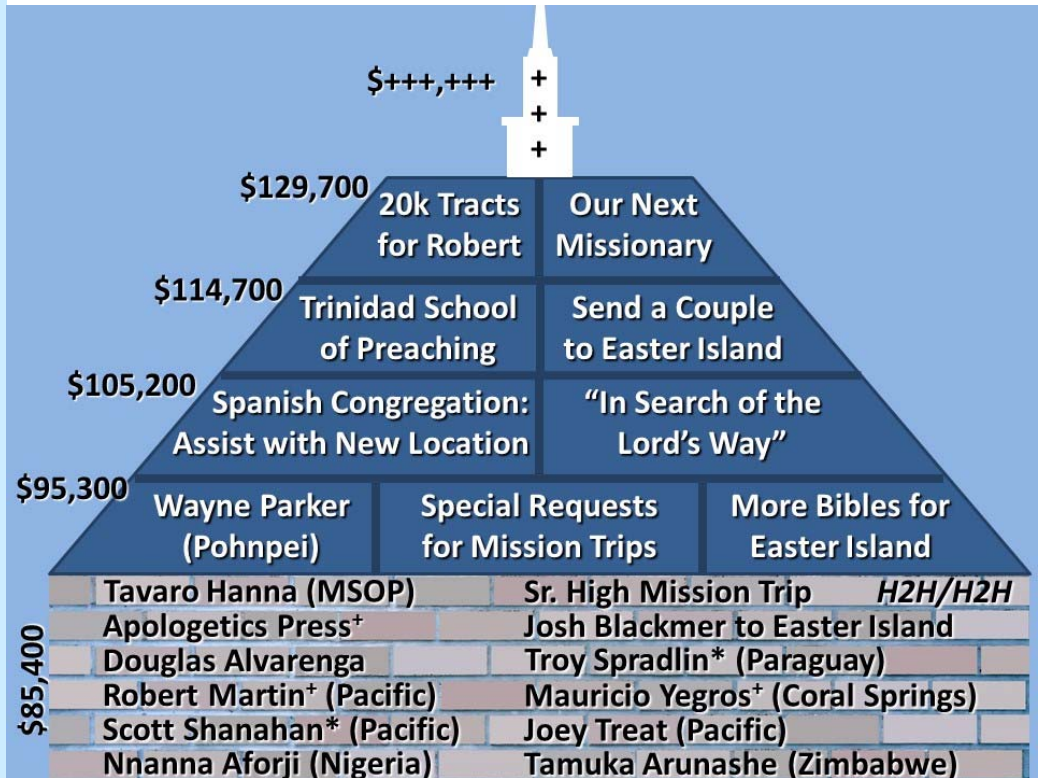

## He Is My EVERYTHING

When John was on Patmos, he saw a vision of Jesus. As our Lord spoke to him, He said, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End" (Rev. 1:8), and three verses later adds, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last." This same idea is found at the end of this book (21:6; 22:14). What is the meaning of the words alpha and omega? They are the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet. To help us understand this we might consider that He is the "A" and the "Z" in our alphabet.

That is precisely what He is. From beginning to end, in every aspect of truth, He is everything. Using our alphabet, what is Jesus to us?

**A=** He is almighty.

**B=** He is the Beginning.

**C=** He is our comforter.

**D=** He is the door.

**E=** He is everlasting.

**F=** He is faithful.

**G=** He is God.

**H=** He is holy.

**I=** He is the I AM.

**From beginning to end, in every aspect of truth, He is everything for us.**

**J=** He is Jehovah.

**K=** He is King of all kings.

**L=** He is Lord of all lords.

**M=** He is the Messiah.

**N=** He is near.

**O=** He is omniscient, omnipresent, omnipotent.

**P=** He is the protector.

**Q=** He is the One who quickens (makes alive) us.

**R=** He is the Redeemer.

**S=** He is the Savior.

**T=** He is truth.

**U=** He is unchanging.

**V=** He is the victory.

**W=** He is the Way.

**X=** He is the *Xristos* (Greek for Christ), the Messiah.

**Y=** He is yes (in all His promises—2 Cor. 1:20).

**Z=** He is zealous (John 2:17) in serving God.

## Keep Your Eye on Your Heart!

I remember one of my early basketball coaches teaching the team how to play on-the-ball defense. In addition to taking a low, wide stance on the balls of our feet and shuffling from side-to-side, he taught us where to look. He told us not to look at the player's head or his feet, because a head fake or stutter step would leave us beat. He taught us to look at their midsection, because (and I can still hear him say this), "He ain't goin' nowhere without his belly." You can't fake with the belly. Where it goes, the body goes. Without exception.

This basketball strategy is based upon a Biblical truth that could be stated in the vernacular of my coach, "He ain't goin' nowhere without his heart." Where the heart goes, the body goes.

In First Kings 11, the wise king Solomon "went after" the gods of Canaan and "did evil in the sight of the Lord" (11:5-6). What would cause the son of David to become an idolater? "His heart" was "turned...after other gods" (11:4). Where his heart went, he went.

Less than 400 years later, the nation of Judah was headed into Babylonian captivity after they had "gone after other gods to serve them" (Jer. 11:10). What would cause an entire nation, which once was faithful to God, to break their

covenant with the Lord? "Everyone followed the dictates of his evil heart" (11:8). Where their hearts went, they went.

Amazingly, the Lord had cautioned against this very thing almost 500 years before Solomon began to reign. In Moses' final words to the children of Israel, he warned the Jews of the time when they would "surely perish" because they would have been "drawn away" to "worship other gods and serve them" (Deut. 30:17-18). What would precipitate their apostasy? "If your heart turns away so that you do not hear..." (v. 17). They would follow their hearts.

Less than a year after Moses spoke those words, Israel was gathered at Mount Sinai, and having "rejected" God, Stephen testified that "in their hearts they turned back to Egypt" (Acts 7:38-39). Having turned away from God, "they made a calf" and "offered sacrifices to the idol" (7:40-42).

Brother and sister in Christ, where is your heart? Don't get "head faked" into believing that your life, your service to God and your faithfulness will go anywhere without your heart first leading the way! If your heart longs for the Lord and His ways, your everyday life will follow right along.

God's desire for His people is the same today as it was nearly 3,500 years ago: "Oh, that they had such a heart in them that they would fear Me and always keep all My commandments, that it might be well with them" (Deut. 5:29).

## Are You Sure That's What It Means?

I am finding it increasingly difficult to trust what we were led to believe were our national stalwarts of truth—the news and the government. The media seems to have an agenda, reporting the news with a twist. Government is just a numbers game and is run as though it were a major corporation. They say, “Vote for a difference!” Yet, it is simply an illusion of control. In the end, the machine may change its outward appearance, but it continues to march to its own drum while we the “sheeple” are made to be happy with the indulgences provided for us.

This is my own personal dismal opinion of a man-made institution, but it stands in stark contrast to the church of God and our Lord Jesus Christ. In God I can find a reason for trust (Psa. 91:2, 4). In His word I can find truth and in His kingdom I find purpose. No matter what is happening around me, I can rest at night with the strong conviction that God is in control. No matter what they say in the news or matter what the machine does, my family and I will go to heaven because of love and obedience.

But, what if we couldn't trust the messenger? What if what we were hearing from the pulpit or from Bible class teachers did not match with what we were reading? Worse yet, what if we didn't know enough to determine if the mes-

sage was truth or not? First, those who preach and teach the word of God have a sacred responsibility. “Woe is me if I do not preach the gospel” (1 Cor. 9:16). “For I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God” (Acts 20:27). “Whoever speaks, is to do so as one who is speaking the utterances of God” (1 Pet. 4:11).

Second, it is imperative that we personally study, learn and grow in knowledge. “Now these were more noble-minded... for they received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so” (Acts 17:11). “For though by this time you ought to be teachers” (Heb. 5:12). “Like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation” (1 Pet. 2:2). We are to work out our own salvation and not be dependent on what we hear (Phil. 2:12). If we follow what men say without cross examination from the word of God, we become sheep of men and not of the Good Shepherd (John 10:11, 14).

Finally, brethren, we must heed the warning of those before us. “The time will come when they will not endure sound (healthy) doctrine... and will turn away their ears from the truth...” (2 Tim. 4:3-4). Who do you trust? Test everything (1 John 4:1; Rev. 2:2). If it is not healthy doctrine, it is poison. Do not willingly or ignorantly be a victim of misinformation.

### You've got protection all around you!

It is one of the most comforting verses in all of the Bible. After receiving two imperatives from the Lord—“Be anxious for nothing” and “let your requests be made known unto God” (Phil. 4:6)—there is this promising reassurance, which has helped many of us to “go on” when we didn't think that we could: “...and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus” (4:7).

We are promised that “the peace of God...will guard [our] hearts and minds.” Think about that for a moment. The Greek word for “guard” is a military term, which pictured soldiers standing on duty, guarding the city gate from the inside, protecting against the enemy. Can you see it?

It is time for Christians to stop carrying all of their “cares” (1 Pet. 5:7) and worrying all of their “worries” (Phil. 4:6), and it is time to allow God's peace to garrison our hearts (emotions) and our minds (thoughts), so that we learn to trust Him and obey Him more every day! – DS



### You can't be a Christian and prejudiced!

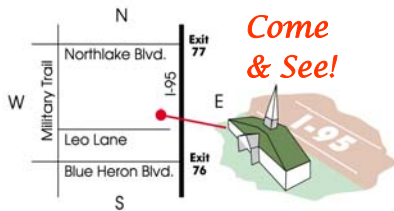
