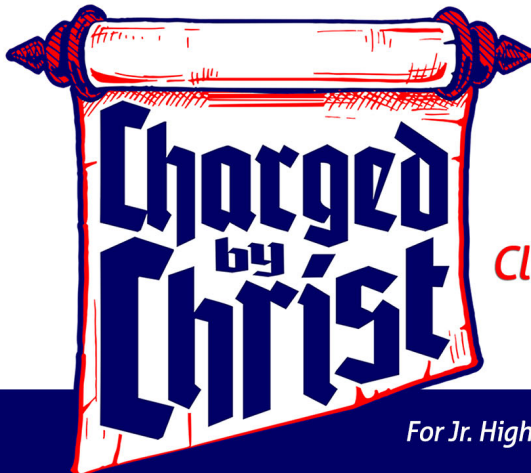

## Not Many Mighty and Noble Are Called—Why?

The words of Paul to the Corinthians reveal so much about the response to the gospel when the lost hear it. “For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called” (1 Cor. 2:26). Why is this true? All of mankind is invited to come to Jesus, but so many of the mighty and noble do not answer the invitation. Much can be learned by looking at those who were mighty or noble who did respond.

There were those whom the Bible describes as noble who did respond. John chapter four describes a nobleman who lived in Capernaum and traveled more than twenty miles to see Jesus in Cana. His child was dying, and he begged Jesus to come and heal his son. Jesus told him to return home for his son would be healed. “So the man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he went on his way” (John 4:50). Read it carefully. Unlike most who are noble and do not respond, this man responded because he believed the word of Jesus. Every noble man who believes and obeys the teaching of Jesus will be saved. Those who do not will be lost—not because they are noble but because they fail to listen to Jesus.

What about the mighty? The mighty are those whose position in life has placed them above others. An example of

this would be centurions, the Roman officers who commanded a hundred soldiers. Why is it that some centurions responded and realized who Jesus was?

Matthew chapter eight and Luke chapter seven describe a centurion who lived in Capernaum. He had used his own money to build a synagogue for the Jews. He sent the elders among the Jews to ask Jesus to heal his sick servant. As Jesus approached his house, the centurion gave this message to Jesus. “Lord, do not trouble Yourself, for I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof.” He was a mighty man but realized the Mighty One. He said, “I did not think myself worthy to come to You. But say the word, and my servant will be healed.”

How did Jesus describe this mighty man? The Lord turned to that crowd who was following Him and said, “I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel” (Luke 7:9). Why did this man, this powerful soldier, find such favor from the Lord? His great faith was verbalized when he said that all that was needed was for Jesus to simply say the word. Mighty men whose hearts respond to the words of Jesus will be among those who are called and become the chosen (Matt. 22:14).

The gospel is for all mankind, but only those who are humble enough to listen to the words of Jesus will become the chosen people of God.

## Immediately Jesus

The key word in Mark’s account of the gospel (at least the term that appears over and over in the book) is the word “immediately.” It is a fun exercise to trace that word through the book of Mark. But knowing how often it appears in that book makes it intriguing to see the word used repeatedly in other books, where it is not considered “a key word.” In Matthew’s recording of Jesus walking on the water, the word “immediately” is found three times. What is especially fascinating and encouraging about these three uses is the word that occurs after “immediately” every single time. Think about this; don’t let this thought escape you too fast. Three times Matthew says, “Immediately Jesus.” Let’s consider what we can learn from this.

**The word that occurs after “immediately” every single time**

Verse 22 (of Matthew 14) says, “Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away.” It was evening time. Earlier in the day, Jesus received news about the beheading of John the Baptist, and He “departed” to a “deserted place by Himself” (14:13). But the multitudes “followed Him.” Jesus’ alone time was interrupted, and He fed the 5,000 men. But Jesus had not had time to grieve for His dear friend. He needed to talk to His Father. So, the “immediately Jesus” is here to lead into Jesus going “up on the mountain by Himself

to pray” (14:23). He could not wait anymore. “He was alone there” on the mountain to spend time with His Father.

Verse 27 says, “But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, ‘Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.’” The intervening verses tell about the disciples getting caught in a storm in the middle of the Sea of Galilee in the middle of the night. Jesus was alone with His Father, but when His friends were in trouble, He went to them. When they were fearful, “immediately Jesus” spoke so that they could hear His voice and calm their anxieties.

Verse 31 says, “And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him...” Jesus had been walking on the water to get to His disciples and then Peter, by faith, got out and walked on the water toward Him. But Peter took His eyes off of Jesus and in a panicked and sinking cry, called out, “Lord, save me!” Without any delay, “immediately Jesus” saved him.

There is so much we can learn from our “immediately Jesus.” Jesus could not wait any longer to spend time with His Father. “Immediately Jesus” moved everything from His schedule and made it happen. When we are in trouble, “immediately Jesus” will be there to calm our fears. When we have lost faith in Him but then realize our dangerous path, “immediately Jesus” will stretch out and save us. Aren’t you glad that you have an “immediately Jesus” as your Friend?

## Who Is Able to Stand?

God is always looking for those that are standing for what is right or standing in the gap (Ezek. 22:30). God has given us what is needed to be able to stand today and stand forever.

Preparation is key to any endeavor, especially when it is connected to our service to God. It would make sense then that God has given us the tools to stand prepared in this life. “Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil... Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. Stand firm therefore...” (Eph. 6:10-14). The full armor of God is so that we can stand firm. In this passage, we are told what it is for and then given the imperative to use it. The application of such a passage is readily available. God asks us to stand, expects us to stand and gives us the tools by which we can stand in this life against the influences of Satan.

How will I be able to stand in the judgment? God has yet again provided. With the opening of the sixth seal in the book of Revelation, we are given an image of judgment. All the bad things that were commonly associated with end times were mentioned, and then “they said to the mountains and to

the rocks, ‘Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb; for the great day of their wrath has come, and who is able to stand?’” (Rev. 6:16-17). The last question—“Who is able to stand in the face of the judgment of the Lamb?”—is as much a statement of despair as it is a question. Yet, it is answered in chapter seven.

“After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could count, from every nation and all tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, and palm branches were in their hands; and they cry out with a loud voice, saying, ‘Salvation to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb.’... Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, ‘These who are clothed in the white robes, who are they, and where have they come from?’...These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb...They will hunger no longer, nor thirst anymore; nor will the sun beat down on them, nor any heat; for the Lamb in the center of the throne will be their shepherd, and will guide them to springs of the water of life; and God will wipe every tear from their eyes” (Rev. 7:9-17). If we stand now and fight the good fight, we are promised that we will stand forever in eternity with Him.

### What a pearl!

Jesus wanted His disciples to know what the church (i.e., the kingdom) would be like, describing its many aspects through parables, including its immeasurable value. The church of Christ is that one pearl of great price! It was bought with the precious blood of Christ (Acts 20:28)! When true searchers find it, they recognize its unique value and must have it! – DS

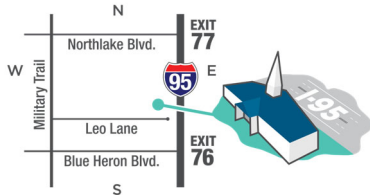
