## Amen, Amen = Verily, Verily

The ancient Hebrews had a word which affirmed the truthfulness of what was said. That same word was literally brought over into the Greek language with the same affirmation about truth. It may seem strange, but that same Hebrew/Greek word became an English word. That word is amen. It appears 30 times in the Old Testament and 132 times in the New Testament. Amen simply means "let it be true" or "it is true." Jesus himself used this word 103 times.

It is not always translated amen. It often is translated "verily" in the KJV. This is seen in the 25 times He emphasized the truth He was about to say and said, "Verily, verily." The NKJV translated this compound usage as "most assuredly." Your life will be enriched when Jesus said, "Amen, amen" or "Verily, verily."

His words are always truth. However, Jesus so often highlighted truth and some fifty times said, "Verily I say to you..." The other fifty times he used the compound phrase. His words are truth. They are very true. They are very truth, very true. Consider the following discussion of truth which Jesus began by saying, "Verily, verily, I say to you."

So many know that Jesus spoke of being born again. However, most have failed to realize how Jesus defines that

new birth. Jesus said, "Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (John 3:3). Nicodemus thought he was speaking of a literal birth, so Jesus expanded what He said. "Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God" (John 3:5).

Being born again is not a fleshly birth, but the creation of a new person, and it truly involved both water and the Spirit. Read the book of Acts as it shows those who were taught the words given by the Spirit entered into water. They were all baptized in water!

The truth that being born again involves both the Spirit and water could have been established by Jesus simply saying that for one to be born again water was involved in it. Jesus chose to emphasize water baptism by beginning His teachings saying "Verily, I say unto you..." Yet, He did more! He said, "Verily, verily I say unto you..." His words are so remarkable. Jesus said, "It is true, it is true..." What is true? That the new birth involves more than the Spirit—it involves water. Jesus taught it involves water. Jesus truly (verily) taught it involves water. Jesus truly, truly taught it involves water!

The next time you read the book of John, pay special attention to the 25 times Jesus said, "Verily, verily." Your life will be changed by doing this kind of study!

## Salvation: It Requires Baptism in Water

Why there is such controversy in the religious community today over the Biblical requirements for one to be saved from sins is rather mind-boggling! The New Testament makes God's conditions for salvation abundantly clear. In order to obtain the forgiveness of sins, one must believe Jesus is God's Son, repent of his sins and confess his faith. All of those are clearly taught. Equally unambiguous is God's requirement for man to be BAPTIZED to be saved.

When a person was properly baptized in the New Testament, it was always by means of immersion. The person would come "to" the water (Matt. 3:11), go "down into the water" (Acts 8:38), be "buried...in baptism" (Col. 2:12), be "raised" from the water (Rom. 6:4) and come "up out of the water" (Acts 8:39). Bible baptism is always immersion.

When a person was properly baptized in the New Testament, it was never an infant or child without proper understanding. The subject who was baptized had always been taught the gospel (Mark 16:15-16), believed the deity of Christ (Mark 16:16), repented of his sins (Acts 2:38) and confessed his faith in Christ (Acts 8:36-38). Bible baptism is always of persons who meet the required pre-conditions.

When a person was properly baptized in the New Tes-

tament, it was always (without exception) for the purpose of being saved from sins at that moment. This is one of the clearest teachings in all of Scripture. Bible baptism always stands between a sinner and being "saved" from sins (Mark 16:16; 1 Pet. 3:21), obtaining "the remission of sins" (Acts 2:38), having sins "washed away" (Acts 22:16), being "freed from sin" (Rom. 6:3-7), being "born again" (John 3:3-7), being able to "enter the kingdom of God" (John 3:5), becoming a "child of God" (Gal. 3:26-27), putting "on Christ" (Gal. 3:27) and becoming a "Christian" (Matt. 28:19+Acts 11:26). The New Testament never teaches, in any verse, that baptism takes place after one has been saved.

When a person was properly baptized in the New Testament, it was the only means for entering "into Christ" (Rom. 6:3; Gal. 3:27). There are no other verses that provide a path "into Christ" than those two, and they both specify being "baptized." It is impossible for one to obtain "every spiritual blessing...in Christ" (Eph. 1:3) without Bible baptism! No truth could be clearer! Jesus further warned that if one is not baptized that "he cannot enter the kingdom of God" (John 3:5).

Thank God that His plan of salvation is so clear! He has done His part! And He makes OUR part to be saved from OUR sins plain—believe Jesus is God's Son, repent of sins, confess faith in Christ and be baptized. But, that is not the end.

## What is Holding You Back?

Last Monday, the African nation of Liba was struck by a devastating flood. It is reported that about 5,300 people have been killed and 10,000 more are currently missing. Those among the survivors must have had to think very quickly and leave most of their possessions behind. If you were in their shoes, would there be some things you might try to grab at the last minute? A change of clothes, family pictures, or a precious heirloom? Perhaps, nothing seemed valuable enough to risk your life for. When your life is on the line, suddenly the essentials become more obvious.

When Paul came to Athens, he noticed an altar dedicated "To the Unknown God." Athens had many gods; one for each natural phenomenon. Paul revealed to the Athenians that, unknowingly, they worshipped the one true God. Paul says He is "...God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands" (NKJV Acts 17:24). God is unlike any god invented by man because He was not carved, cast, or imagined. He is the designer.

The idols the Greeks worshipped had no power. They had no lasting value. How could people think that something fashioned by man would be worthy of their devotion? Paul

states, "we ought not to think that the Divine Nature is like gold or silver or stone, something shaped by art and man's devising" (v. 29b). God is far above our imagination and anything physical. But, we fashion idols out of the physical every day. We place value in the accumulation of possessions, wealth, and notoriety. We look to social media for self-worth and approval.

We are not only physical beings. We have an eternal soul. With the current state of the world, now is the time to start worrying about the things that really matter. There is a God who loves you and created you with the desire to discover Him (v. 27-28). Leave your idols behind and cling to the one true God. "Because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead" (v. 31).

When the Athenians heard Paul speak of the resurrection, some mocked him and some procrastinated, but some believed. The believers joined Paul, but the others were left behind. They couldn't let go of their idols. What is holding you back from following Christ? Do you realize that we are not guaranteed tomorrow? If you are not in Christ, then your soul is in danger. What idols are you clinging to when the time to seek shelter is at hand? Choose this day to live for Christ.

### Hebrew midwives were wiser than many today

3,500 years ago, the king of Egypt grew increasingly concerned about the size and might of the Israelite nation. The king instructed the Hebrew midwives to take matters into their hands: "When you do the duties of a midwife for the Hebrew women, and see them on the birthstools, if it is a son, then you shall kill him; but if it is a daughter, then she shall live" (Ex. 1:16).

How primitive! How could those inexperienced midwives know if the child born was a son (i.e., a male/boy) or a daughter (i.e., a female/girl)? Did they ask the child what they were? Did they wait so that they could administer hormone blockers or perform gender-altering surgery?

No! What those midwives knew 3,500 years ago has been known since the beginning of time and even to the present! Boys have boy parts, and girls have girl parts. No personal feelings, drugs or surgeries can change a boy into a girl or a girl into a boy. God made two genders (male and female, Gen. 1:27). There are only two, and they are unchangeably set upon conception and distinguishably identifiable at birth! It really is that simple! – DS



### Don't let your heart be melted

Forty-five years after the twelve spies returned from spying out the Promised Land and the people of Israel believed and followed the pessimistic perspective of the ten spies, Caleb recalled the effect of that faithless report. This faithful spy, in his old age, said, "My brethren who went up with me made the heart of the people melt" (Josh. 14:8).

This same evaluation of those days was made by Moses before his death, when he recounted, "Our brethren have made our hearts melt, saying, 'The people are greater and taller than we. The cities are great and fortified up to heaven'" (Deut. 1:28). The heart of the people melted because they listened to the wrong people. They listened to men who did not listen to God. God promised to "give the land" to His obedient people (Num. 13:2), to "fight for" them (Deut. 1:30) and "carry" them (1:31), but they listened to men and not to God.

He makes those same promises to us today, but we must trust Him and obey Him! Don't let your heart be melted by listening to faithless naysayers! Listen to God! – DS


