#### Auditorium (Dan Jenkins): The Book of Judges

The spiritual leadership provided by Joshua enabled Israel to take the Promised Land. Following his death, Israel turned to idolatry. God used the Gentile nations to punish them until they repented, and then He raised up judges to bring freedom. They were faithful while the judge lived—the pattern is repeated again and again. The study of Judges will change your life.

### **Three Biblical Disembarkations**

I assume that most individuals know the difference between embarkation and disembarkation. As more and more people are going on cruises, we have felt the excitement of either getting on (embarking) or getting off (disembarking) the ship. There are great lessons to be learned from looking at

disembarkations in the Bible.

Worshiping God After You Leave. If I were to ask you who was the first person who left a ship in Biblical history, I suspect that you would know it was Noah. His "ocean cruise" shows us what is truly important as we "cruise" every day of our lives. God was with Noah, and He is with us.

When God shut the door of the ark, we might tend to think in terms of a heavenly hand

reaching down and securing Noah and his family safely in the ark as the door closed. Look carefully at the text. God did not tell Noah to *go* into the ark, but to *come* into the ark. God was inside the ark awaiting Noah. He was never alone inside that vessel.

Does it surprise you what Noah did immediately upon leaving the ark? He built an altar and worshiped God. Whenever we are living conscious of His presence, worship is not an afterthought. Worship is what we long to do! Serving God After You Leave. There is another Bible account of what an individual did after disembarking. He actually was on two ocean going vessels, but neither "cruise" was enjoyable. Jonah's two vessels were the ship he boarded in Joppa, and the belly of the great fish God made. God was part of both "cruises." He made the storm and made the great fish.

Look at what Jonah did after he "disembarked." He realized that God was sovereign and obeyed Him even doing

what he had been refusing to do. Sometimes we struggle to do what God says, but this event shows us that the Lord will not change His will because it is hard for us to do! The message after the two "cruises" was identically the same as it was before. God help us to learn this eternal truth.

Trusting God After You Leave. The final disembarkation happened on the Sea of Galilee. In the midst of the storm Jesus came walking to His disciples who were being tossed about and in dire trouble. Peter's faith was strong enough to step from the boat, but when his fear of the waves became greater than his faith he began to sink. The Lord heard his short prayer and reached out to save him. Never overlook the faith that the apostle showed and remember that the Lord accepts us, even with faltering faith.

So, throughout your cruise, live so at the "final port" you will have worshiped Him, served Him and trusted Him.



### Would You Ever Bring Yourself to Do This to Jesus?

In Luke 7, Jesus was invited by a Pharisee named Simon to eat in his home. While Jesus sat at the table, "a woman in the city" entered the scene. If it were not for this woman, we may not even have the record of this dinner, for the woman and Simon's response to her are the whole focus.

First of all, think about what this woman does when

she is in the presence of Jesus. She would have known that she was not a welcome guest on this occasion, but nothing was going to stop her from getting to Jesus. She had prepared for this encounter by bringing "an alabaster flask of fragrant oil" (7:37). This was not a chance meeting. She thought ahead.

When she arrived, she "stood at His feet

behind Him" (7:38). She was not presumptuous enough to stand in front and make herself the center of attention. Instead, her humility focused on the feet of Jesus, which would have been tucked behind Him as He inclined at the table. This woman desperately wanted to be in the presence of Jesus, but she did not feel worthy to be there.

What did she do at the feet of Jesus? She was "weeping, and she began to wash His feet with her tears, and wiped them with the hair of her head; and she kissed His feet

and anointed them with the fragrant oil" (7:38). The verb tenses in this verse denote ongoing action—she kept on weeping, washing, wiping, kissing and anointing. It was not a quick "one-and-done" action but something she kept repeating.

Go back and read the last three paragraphs. Make the application. Could you...Would you have done this?

But, here's the question. WHY was she doing this? Simon the Pharisee accused her of being (present tense, right now) "a sinner" (7:39). However, the text does not support her still bearing her sins. The Holy Spirit tells us that she "was a sinner"—a past tense verb (7:37). Simon used a present tense, but the Holy Spirit used a past tense. Who are you going to believe? Her sins were in her past.

Isus emphasized this further when He used a different tense regarding her sins. The Son of God told both Simon and this woman that her sins "are forgiven" (7:47-48). By using the Greek perfect tense, Jesus emphasized that her sins had been forgiven in the past and the result of that forgiveness was still ongoing in the present.

So, back to the question. WHY was this woman doing this? Jesus gives us the reason: Her sins had been forgiven! Brethren, what do we humbly do for and to Jesus as a result of Him forgiving us of our sins? Have we lost sight of how precious and powerful that gift is? May it never be!


